WHEREAS, oncology data specialists record and maintain vital information about each person's case, which is crucial for cancer treatment and research; and

WHEREAS, information reported by oncology data specialists is used to learn more about the causes of cancer, detect cancer earlier, and increase the chance of finding a cure for cancer; and

WHEREAS, the information is also used to make treatment decisions and to help determine whether treatment worked, with an ultimate goal of preventing cancer; and

WHEREAS, we acknowledge the hard work and dedication of oncology data specialists for all that they do to improve the health and well-being of Ohioans; and
