

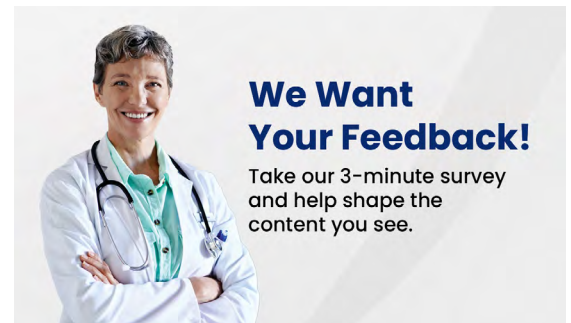

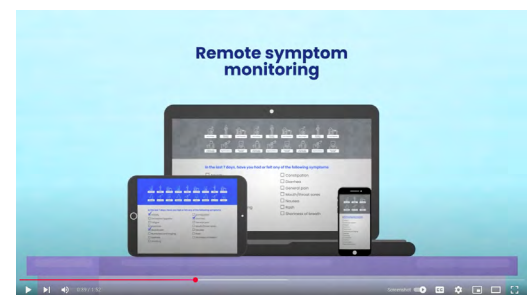


Remote Symptom Monitoring Video

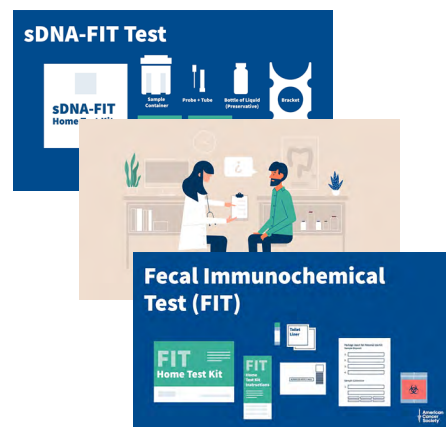


Colorectal Cancer Screening Modality Videos

As of January 1, 2025, an estimated 18.6 million people had a history of cancer, a number projected to exceed 22 million by 2035, according to a new ACS report, [Cancer Treatment and Survivorship Statistics, 2025](#). The study, published in *CA: A Cancer Journal for Clinicians*, also found notable disparities in treatment for many common cancers, including lung and colorectal. 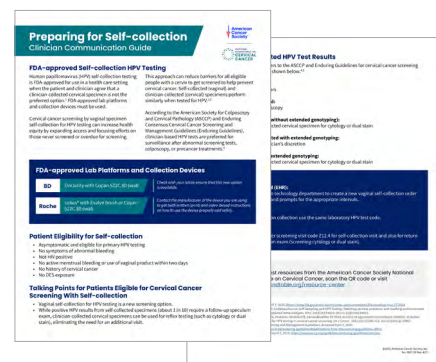
